How We Use Your Information

We use the collected information for the following purposes:

- ****To send you newsletters, updates, and promotional materials** (only with your explicit consent, where required by law).
- ****To analyze website usage trends** and improve our content and user experience.
- ****To comply with legal obligations** and protect our rights and interests.

Legal Basis for Data Processing

We process your personal data on the following legal bases:
